**Project 35** is an ICI exhibition contingent on the combined perspective of many. Selected by 35 international curators who each chose one single-channel video work from an artist they think is important for audiences around the world to experience today, **Project 35** reflects a multiplicity of artistic voices and opinions. The exhibition draws on ICI's network of curators to trace complex regional and global connections among artists from places as varied as Moldova, Ethiopia and Korea.

The works in the second version of the exhibition, *Project 35 Volume 2*, reflect on culture and daily life from 35 different positions. The videos range from Aníbal López's political documentation of presidential elections in Guatemala, to Ahmet Ögüt's meditation on sound, youth and modernity in Turkey. Remarkably, 13 out of 35 artists in this exhibition are working in Asia and 10 out of 35 curators are based in Asia as well. While highlighting contemporary art production in Asia, these works no less can be shared, understood and appreciated globally.

To celebrate <u>Asian Contemporary Art Week (ACAW)</u> ICI will present videos from **Project 35 Volume 2** as special screening event at our curatorial hub in lower Manhattan.
