Tyler Rollins Fine Art in New York is hosting an exhibition titled “Shadow of the Past” featuring works of Arahmaiani that will be on view through October 29, 2016.

The exhibition is a solo exhibition of new works by one of Indonesia’s most respected contemporary artist Arahmaiani. The artist is internationally recognized for her powerful commentaries on social, political and cultural issues. Her artistic practice ranges a wide variety of media, including video,

installation, painting, drawing and sculpture. In recent years, the focus of her work has been on environmental issues in the Tibetan plateau region. The exhibition is devoted to her artworks inspired by her experiences in Tibet. It features two new installation works, videos, and a series of monochromatic paintings, each focusing on the themes of spirituality, the interconnectedness of humanity and nature, and the cycle of life and death, all with a feminist touch.
